The study identified the variables involved in making the ultimate cup of tea, from how many times it should be stirred and the teabag squeezed, to the number of sugars to reveal the miracle formula:

Squeeze teabag 1-2 times

- + A bit of milk, to medium colour
- + 1-2 tspns of sugar
- + stir 3/4 times
- = THE PERFECT TRADESMAN'S TEA

Or in short, $Tea\ bag(1) + squeeze(1.5) + bt\ o'milk + sugar(1.5) + stir(3.5) = The\ Perfect\ Tradesman's$ Tea.
